

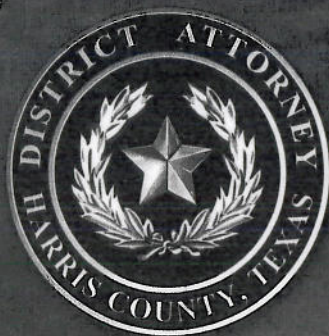


The Harris County District Attorney's Office is pleased to introduce your family to ComputerCOP software monitoring tool as part of your comprehensive Internet safety plan.

Dear Chief Otto:

We conclude that use of \$50,000 to purchase and distribute this software to the community would be a permissible use of equitable sharing funds.

The additional information demonstrated that the software provides direct support to law enforcement, and has already proven to be an effective law enforcement aid in actual cases. The new information also indicated that the software might be used with current forensic capabilities of law enforcement agencies to gather even more information to identify and locate perpetrators and possibly missing children. The software enables parents to be able to print what they find so they may give the printouts to law enforcement. The software also allows parents to view email addresses and instant messages if they are in HTML format. Thus, the software's coverage and effectiveness is greater than what we had originally thought based on the initial information provided.

Further, the additional information, and the better understanding we now have of the software's capabilities, alleviates our concerns that there would be any appearance of impropriety by distributing this software to the public at no cost. It appears to be a valid crime prevention tool, as well as a law enforcement aid in a broad array of cases.

Thank you for taking the time to provide the additional information regarding this initiative. We would request that the Suffolk County Sheriff's Department provide us with feedback as to the success of the program. Phoebe Prince, South Hadley High School's 'new girl,' driven to suicide by teenage Cyber Bullies

BOSTON (CBS/AP) School officials at South Hadley High School didn't follow all the anti-bullying advice they were given months before 15-year-old Phoebe Prince committed suicide, according to a consultant who offered the tips.

Barbara Coloroso said she consulted with parents and administrators months before the harassed freshman hanged herself in January.

Police say she endured months of verbal assaults and threats, mostly in school and in person, although some of the bullying occurred on **Facebook and in other electronic forms.**

"The questions to ask are: Did they follow their own rules and did they keep Phoebe safe? Obviously not. **And**, did they deal effectively with the bullies? Obviously not," Coloroso told The Associated Press Tuesday.

Nine students face charges in connection with the girl's death, including two teen boys charged with statutory rape and a clique of girls charged with stalking, criminal harassment and violating Phoebe's civil rights.

School officials won't be charged, even though authorities say they knew about the bullying.

South Hadley High School is located in South Hadley, Mass., about 90 miles east of Boston.

MySpace-fueled runaway attempt

State troopers intercepted a 12-year-old Brookline runaway as she got out of her cab at Logan International Airport yesterday, ticket in hand, and headed for Hollywood - lured by a possible sexual predator she met online.

"She had a dream of becoming a movie star," said Brookline Police Capt. John O'Leary.

O'Leary said the girl's encounter with someone claiming to be a 16-year-old girl in Los Angeles began on the **MySpace** talent page, and online chats led to frequent text messaging. Police are now investigating whether the person in California was a sexual predator posing as a teenage girl.

"The 16-year-old offered to help get her into shows," O'Leary said, adding that the LA teen claimed she was friendly with teen heartthrob and movie star Dylan Thomas Sprouse and promised to introduce her to him.

"She wanted to become an actress. That's why she was going to LA," O'Leary said.

The unsuspecting Brookline girl's California dreaming was initially undone by a farewell text message to two school chums, tapped out on the cab ride to Logan's Terminal B after she left school yesterday.

A schoolmate contacted authorities, who alerted Brookline police about 9:30 a.m.

Brookline cops called the staties at Logan, telling them to watch for the missing girl, who was expected to board a late-morning **American Airlines**

According to a police source, the girl snuck her grandmother's credit card to buy the ticket. Brookline police tracked down the girl's mother and rushed her to the state police barracks at the airport.

"The troopers observed a child getting out of a cab by herself at the terminal and realized that this was probably the girl they were looking for," Procopio said. "They confronted her and she was brought back to the barracks and safely reunited with her mom."

O'Leary warned parents not to let children use the Internet unsupervised or in their rooms alone, and to make them aware of the potential for predators and people misrepresenting themselves.

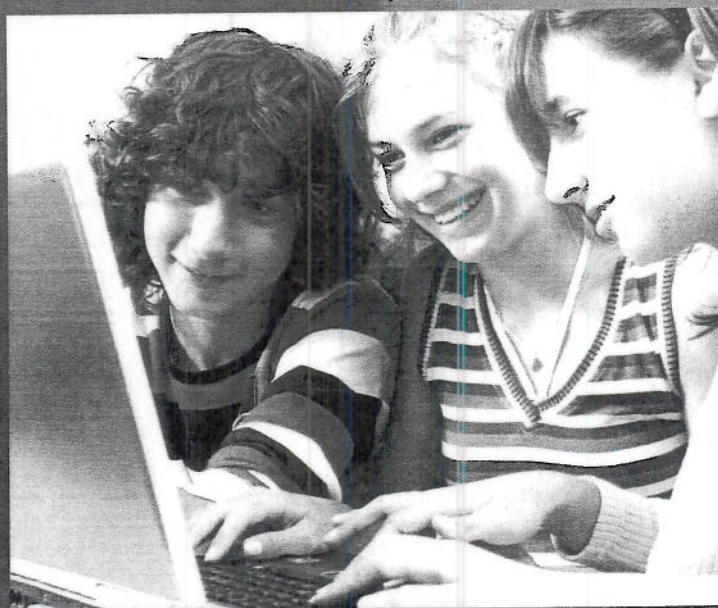

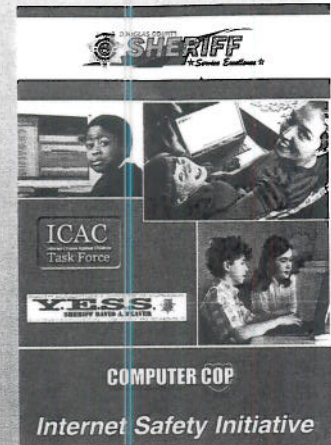
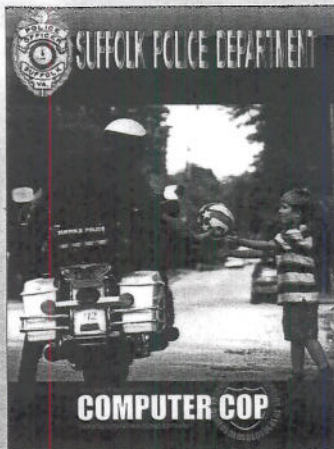
