ORDER

The parties are ordered to submit supplemental briefs addressing whether and how the amendments to 18 U.S.C. § 2709 and 18 U.S.C. § 3511 (enacted as part of the USA FREEDOM Act of 2015, signed into law on June 2, 2015) affect these appeals.

These supplemental briefs shall be no longer than 15 pages and shall be submitted no later than July 6, 2015. All briefs shall conform to the format requirements of Rule 32(a)(4), (5) and (6), Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure. Parties who are registered for ECF must file the supplemental brief electronically without submission of paper copies. Parties who are not registered ECF filers must file the original supplemental brief plus 7 copies.
