I am responding to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request (EPA-HQ-2016-003347) for Environmental Protection Agency records, documents, and reports related to the Reducing Over-Classification Act, P.L. 111-258, Section 6(a): Incentives for Accurate Classifications.

The EPA does not offer, and has not offered, cash incentives for accurate classifications. We do not have the records, documents, and reports you requested.

Under the FOIA, you have the right to appeal this determination. EPA must receive your appeal within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter. The agency will not consider appeals received after the 30 calendar day limit. The appeal must be in writing and should include the HQ-2016 tracking number assigned to your request (above), copies of your initial request and the response letter from the agency, and the reasons for your appeal. You may submit your appeal letter by U.S. Postal Service mail, courier service, fax or email.


