We let you choose your own insulin, mix-and-match your continuous glucose monitor and pump—and we let you (and

everyone else in the world) **audit our sourcecode**, to help us spot and patch bugs that could let jerks and sociopaths spy on you or even kill you by taking over your closed loop.

Your diabetes can kill you. Humans are crappy lab-techs (especially when their blood sugar is going crazy), so it only makes sense to trust a computer to maintain your insulin levels for you. But when that computer is part of your body, you (not a corporation and not even your parents) **you should be in charge** of who gets to monitor and reprogram it.
