

1 Petitioner Voss's petition for peremptory writ of mandate is granted.

2 The court directs respondent to provide petitioner with records identifying the race and/or
3 ethnicity of each person currently or formerly in the custody of the California Department of
4 Corrections and Rehabilitation for whom a parole suitability hearing was held between January 1,
5 2002 and November 30, 2019. As more fully explained in the companion case of *Brodheim v.*
6 *CDCR*, CGC-20-516978, the cited information is not exempt from disclosure. Gov't Code § 6254(k)
7 does not bar the disclosure. The Penal Code does not proscribe the release of the information
8 because it is not "criminal offender record information." 15 CCR § 3261.2 is not "federal or state
9 law" that bars disclosure. Gov't Code § 6254(c) does not exempt disclosure because respondent fails
10 to show an unwarranted invasion of privacy based on balancing the competing interests at stake.
