RE: 2023 CLETS Misuse Investigation

On April 04, 2024, the Riverside County Sheriff's Department Professional Standards Bureau was notified of 227 CLETS misuses within our CCW Unit. The CCW Unit was contacted and confirmed the misuse. The misuse was not intentional, and a TAP employee was unaware CLETS was unable to be used for CCW purposes. This TAP employee was retrained on processing CCW applications, the training program now stresses not using CLETS, and communications was sent to all CCW employees stressing that CLETS shall not be used for CCW permits.

No further action is anticipated in this matter.

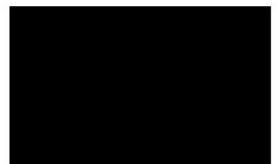
