Dear Dave Maass:

On March 22, 2024, the Attorney General's Office (the Department) received your request seeking records under the Public Records Act (PRA), as set forth in Government Code section 7920.000 et seq.

Specifically, you requested:

- 1) All CLETS misuse reports covering 2022, including reports disclosing no misuse cases;*
- 2) All spreadsheets aggregating CLETS misuse reports covering 2022, including spreadsheets covering reports of no misuse;*
- 3) List of agencies that failed to provide a CLETS misuse report for 2022;*
- 4) All CLETS misuse reports covering 2023, including reports disclosing no misuse cases;*
- 5) All spreadsheets aggregating CLETS misuse reports covering 2023, including spreadsheets covering reports of no misuse; and*
- 6) List of agencies that failed to provide a CLETS misuse report for 2023;*
- 7) List of agencies added to and removed from CLETS in 2022-2023; and*
- 8) The current CLETS PPP.*

The Department issued a response with a portion of the records you were seeking on May 5, 2024, responding to items 7 and 8 of your request. In that correspondence, we informed you that we were continuing to review additional records for anticipated disclosure.

The Department is now disclosing a second installment of responsive records. In response to items 2 and 5 of your request, this installment includes the 2022 and 2023 spreadsheets of California Law Enforcement Telecommunications System (CLETS) Misuse data.

In response to item number 6 of your request, we are additionally providing a list of Originating Agency Identifiers (ORI) that failed to provide a CLETS misuse report for 2023. In response to item number 3 of your request, we have no record of any agencies that failed to provide CLETS misuse reports for 2022, as such, we have no records responsive to this portion of your request.

We are continuing to review additional records to determine whether any privileges or exemptions apply that require redaction. We anticipate that additional responsive, non-exempt records will be available on or about June 28, 2024. If any responsive records are redacted or withheld from our productions, we will provide an explanation for doing so with that production.
