Re: Public Records Act Request 2024-00831

Dear Dave Maass:

On March 22, 2024, the Attorney General's Office (Department) received your request seeking records under the Public Records Act (PRA), as set forth in Government Code section 7920.000 et seq.

Specifically, you requested:

- 1) All CLETS misuse reports covering 2022, including reports disclosing no misuse cases;*
- 2) All spreadsheets aggregating CLETS misuse reports covering 2022, including spreadsheets covering reports of no misuse;*
- 3) List of agencies that failed to provide a CLETS misuse report for 2022;*
- 4) All CLETS misuse reports covering 2023, including reports disclosing no misuse cases;*
- 5) All spreadsheets aggregating CLETS misuse reports covering 2023, including spreadsheets covering reports of no misuse; and*
- 6) List of agencies that failed to provide a CLETS misuse report for 2023;*
- 7) List of agencies added to and removed from CLETS in 2022-2023; and*
- 8) The current CLETS PPP.*

The Department issued a response with a portion of the records you were seeking on May 5, 2024, responding to items 7 and 8 of your request. The Department issued additional records on June 13, 2024 in response to items 2, 5, and 6 of your request and we informed you that we were continuing to review additional records for anticipated disclosure. Please note, in our May 5 correspondence, we explained that, to the extent item 1 is seeking the misuse reports, the data contained in those California Law Enforcement Telecommunications System misuse reports is

entirely reflected in the spreadsheet aggregating the misuse reports that we produced on June 13, 2024. Due to the duplication of information, and in an effort to get information to you more efficiently, we asked you to confirm whether you were still interested in the misuse reports. As we did not hear back from you, we assume you are satisfied with the spreadsheets produced on June 13, 2024. Nevertheless, if you are still interested in the misuse reports, we can provide them upon your request.

The Department is now disclosing the final installment of responsive records. This installment includes attachments to misuse reports where additional documentation was required pursuant to the instructions on the form. We have redacted certain private identifying or personal information as permitted or required by law based on considerations of personal privacy. (See, e.g., Pen. Code, § 832.7, subd. (b)(5)(A); Gov. Code, §§ 6254, subds. (c) and (k), incorporating Cal. Const., art. I, §1; Gov. Code, § 6255.) This concludes our response to your request.
