Dear Dave Maass:

On March 22, 2024, the Attorney General's Office received your request seeking records under the Public Records Act (PRA), as set forth in Government Code section 7920.000 et seq.

Specifically, you requested:

- 1) All CLETS misuse reports covering 2022, including reports disclosing no misuse cases;*
- 2) All spreadsheets aggregating CLETS misuse reports covering 2022, including spreadsheets covering reports of no misuse;*
- 3) List of agencies that failed to provide a CLETS misuse report for 2022;*
- 4) All CLETS misuse reports covering 2023, including reports disclosing no misuse cases;*
- 5) All spreadsheets aggregating CLETS misuse reports covering 2023, including spreadsheets covering reports of no misuse; and*
- 6) List of agencies that failed to provide a CLETS misuse report for 2023;*
- 7) List of agencies added to and removed from CLETS in 2022-2023; and*
- 8) The current CLETS PPP.*

To the extent you are seeking the current California Law Enforcement Telecommunications System (CLETS) Policies, Practices and Procedures (PPP) and a list of agencies added to and removed from CLETS in 2022-2023, the California Department of Justice (Department) has complied with your request and attached the responsive records. For future reference, the most current version of the PPP is also available on the Attorney General's website at <https://oag.ca.gov/publications#clets>.

Regarding your request for a list of agencies added to and removed from CLETS, each agency can have multiple Originating Agency Identifiers (ORI) in the system with individual ORIs being added to or removed from the system on an independent basis. We have interpreted your request to be seeking a list of ORIs that have been added to or removed from CLETS regardless of whether or not the agency may still be a CLETS subscriber with another ORI. The records we are providing reflects that interpretation, please advise if we are interpreting this portion of your request incorrectly.

To the extent you are seeking spreadsheets aggregating misuse reports and a list of agencies that failed to report CLETS misuse for the calendar years 2022 and 2023, the Department is in the process of reviewing additional records responsive to your request and intends to make non-exempt and compliant data available to you on a rolling basis. We anticipate that additional responsive, non-exempt records will be available on or about June 3, 2024. If any responsive records are redacted or withheld from our productions, we will provide an explanation for doing so with that production.

To the extent you are seeking CLETS misuse reports in addition to the spreadsheets aggregating misuse reports, please note, the data contained in the CLETS misuse reports is entirely reflected in the spreadsheet aggregating the misuse reports that will be provided in our next production. Please confirm whether you are still interested in the CLETS misuse reports, and the spreadsheets aggregating misuse reports despite this duplication of information. If we do not hear from you within 20 days of receipt of this letter, we will assume you are no longer interested in this component of the request because you will be receiving the same information in the form of the spreadsheet. Regardless, we assume that you are interested in receiving addendum records submitted by some reporting agencies as supporting documentation for their CLETS misuse report, as this information is not captured in the spreadsheet, we will provide these in a subsequent production.
