Subject: Letter of Reprimand FN20-0062

Between April 10, 2020 and April 16, 2020, you were made aware of your mother's April 10, 2020 non-injury traffic collision which occurred outside of Fullerton's city limits. Initially it was believed the accident occurred in the city of Huntington Beach but it was ultimately determined the traffic collision occurred in the city of Fountain Valley. You accessed the CLETS system through ELETE to check the driver of another involved vehicle for his license status. You also checked what you believed was an Arizona license plate to obtain more information about the driver and/or the vehicle. Through CLETS/ELETE, you discovered the driver of the other vehicle had a suspended or revoked driver's license. You then called the Huntington Beach Police Department and furnished this information in hopes to make a police report. A report was not taken by the Huntington Beach Police Department. However, the Huntington Beach Police Department notified Fullerton Police administration that you may have violated CLETS and had contacted them to further a collision investigation involving your mother.

On November 17, 2020, Administrative Staff reviewed the circumstances of this administrative investigation, including a CLETS test, ELETE inquiries, audio recordings of phone conversations, statements from your interview, and concluded your actions violated department policy. After thorough review of the incident, I have **SUSTAINED** the following allegations of violations of Department Policy:

FPD Manual Section Policy 807.4 Access to protected information.

FPD Manual Section Policy 320.5.1 Laws, Rules and Orders (c) Violation of federal, state, local or administrative laws, rules or regulations.

Furthermore, I have determined you receive a Written Reprimand as discipline. Your mother was involved in a traffic collision outside the jurisdiction of the Fullerton Police Department. This investigation had no nexus to your assignment in Narcotics or even your position as a Fullerton

Police Officer. Instead of allowing the appropriate authorities to conduct the investigation, you used your position and access to CLETS systems to obtain details that you did not have the "right" or "need" to know. This is a direct violation of established CLETS policies, for which you are tested annually and given your experience as a police officer, unequivocally should have known. Your use of systems to further an investigation you had no "right" or "need" to conduct reflects negatively on the Fullerton Police Department. Similar violations could result in further discipline, up to and including termination.

This reprimand will not be placed into your personnel file unless and until you waive or exhaust your right to an administrative appeal.
