18 U.S.C. § 115: Influencing, impeding, or retaliating against a federal official

It's a federal crime to assault, kidnap, or murder—or threaten to do so—a federal law enforcement officer with the intent to impede, intimidate, or interfere with them in the performance of their official duties.

This deals with the open organization of people to impede immigration based investigations and operations. This is also a serious threat to law enforcement officer safety.

Hello,

A summons for records issued under 19 U.S.C. § 1509(a) may only demand that Meta "produce records, as defined in subsection (d)(1)(A)," *id.* § 1509(a)(2). Subsection (d)(1)(A) defines "records" as those for "which there is probable cause to believe that they pertain to merchandise the importation of which into the United States is prohibited." *id.* § 1509(d)(1)(A). Based on the information you have submitted, Meta does not understand your summons to fall within that statutory authorization. For Meta to continue processing your request, please provide information about the offense under investigation and the summons' relevance to that investigation.
