Thus, such merchandise has been imported into the customs territory of the US but, it's not subject to payment of duties, among other things, until it is withdrawn for consumption. Merchandise can be withdrawn from the zone and entered for consumption into the US, moved in bond into a bonded warehouse for manipulation, or exported (just to mention a few of the possibilities). On the export issue, on March 9, 2006, 19 U.S.C. 1595a was amended to add subsection (d), which provides for the seizure of goods exported contrary to law. While we have not yet drafted implementing regulations for 1595a(d), we still cite/follow that provision of law.

As for in-transit movements, while there are no provisions dealing specifically with "in-transit" seizures, we effect seizures under other authorities against goods moving in transit. When we detect the goods on inbound, we seize under those statutes/regs dealing with importations; when we catch them going outbound, we cite to 1595a(d).

On [REDACTED] bonding [REDACTED] we have the authority here to impose bonding provisions in IPR cases. We have exercised that authority in one limited context: violations involving "possibly piratical" copyright violations. In this scenario, covered by 19 CFR 133.43, when CBP detains merchandise which we suspect, but cannot fully determine, constitutes a violation of copyright, we request the copyright owner to post a bond equal to 120% of the dutiable value of the shipment. If the owner does so, we then engage in an administrative adversarial proceeding on the briefs. At the end of the process, if the copyright owner prevails, we return the bond. If the importer prevails, they may proceed against the bond to recover and loss/damages that may have resulted from the detention, if any.

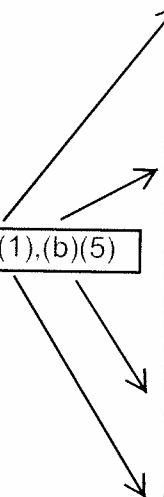

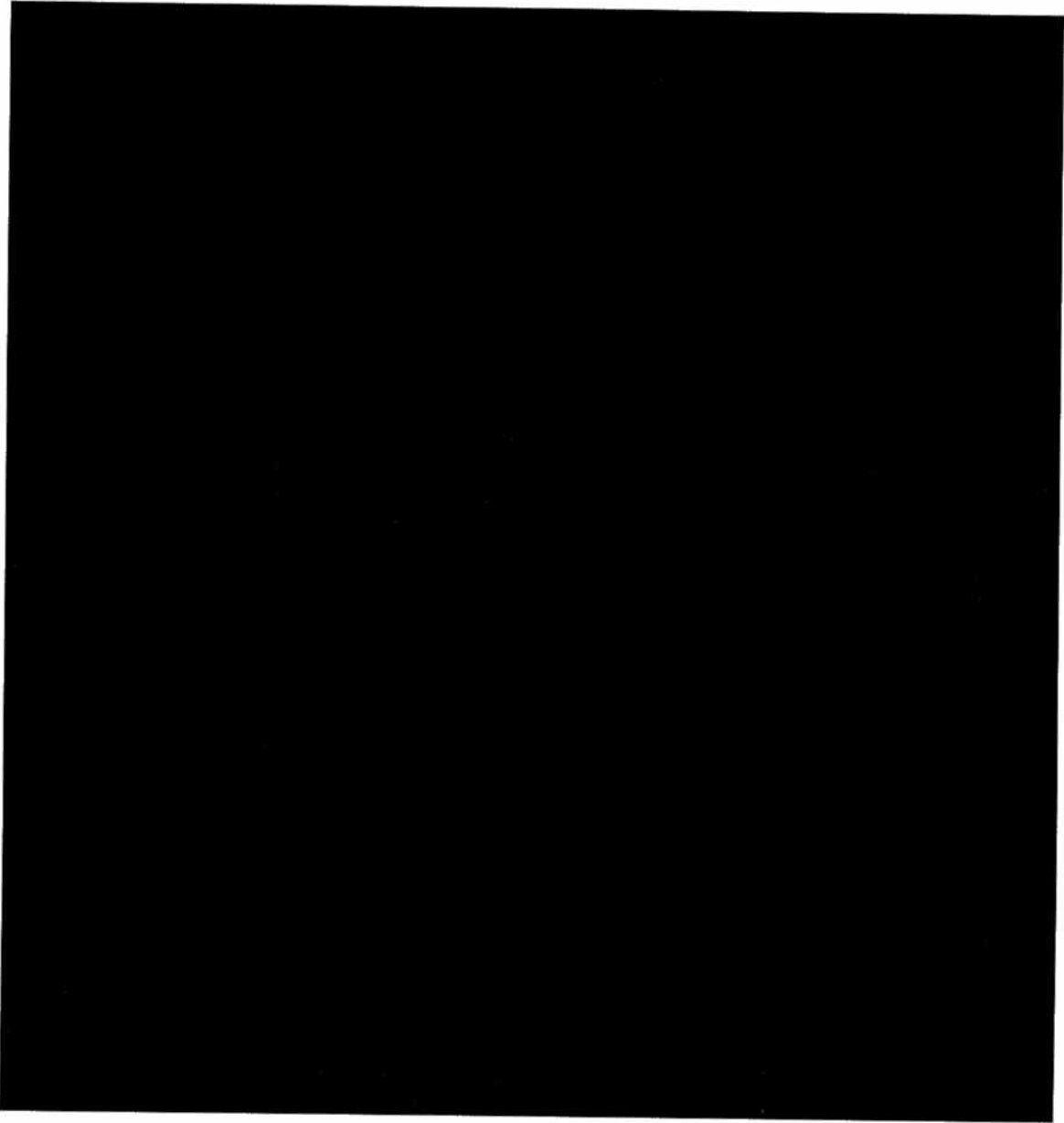


