By the District Director, Seattle District Office, Western Region, Enforcement Bureau:

- 1. This is an Official Citation issued pursuant to Section 503(b)(5) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended ("Act"), to Mr. Cho for violation of 15.5(b) of the Commission's rules ("Rules").²
- 2. In response to a complaint of interference, an investigation by the Enforcement Bureau's Seattle Office revealed that on August 6, 2008, a Part 15 device³ attached to a television owned by Mr. Cho was causing interference to airplanes and the FAA's SEATAC Airport Control Tower on frequency 119.200 MHz.
- 3. Section 15.5(b) of the Rules states "[o]peration of an intentional, unintentional, or incidental radiator is subject to the conditions that no harmful interference is caused...."
- 4. Violations of the Act or the Commission's Rules may subject the violator to substantial monetary forfeitures, seizure of equipment through *in rem* forfeiture action, and criminal sanctions, including imprisonment.
- 5. Mr. Cho may request an interview at the closest FCC Office, which is Federal Communications Commission, 11410 NE 122nd Way, Suite 312, Kirkland, 98034-6927. Mr. Cho may contact this office by telephone, (425) 820-6271 to schedule this interview, which must
