6 sources and Organization for Intellectual Property Act of  
7 2008 (15 U.S.C. 8113) or any other provision of law, the  
8 President may not accept, or provide for the entry into  
9 force with respect to the United States of, any legally  
10 binding trade agreement that imposes obligations on the

1 United States with respect to the enforcement of intellec-  
2 tual property rights, including the Anti-Counterfeiting  
3 Trade Agreement, without the formal and express ap-  
4 proval of Congress.
